IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

We are required to report the results of monitoring of your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis by FEB 2020. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During FEB 2020, we did not report the results of monitoring for total coliform.

Our system failed to notify the state drinking water program as required by FEB 2020. Although public health was not impacted, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

What is being done?

While we did not notify the state as quickly as we should have, we reported the results on 03/03/2020 and were no longer in violation.
